As you will appreciate, homework has an important and useful contribution in regards to your child's education. It supports the development of personal organisation, diligence, independent working and research which both reinforces and extends learning.

There is a homework club at the school which runs every Tuesday and Thursday from 3.00pm-4.30pm in the sixth form study room – 705. This is fully staffed, and has full ICT provision. It is a quiet purposeful atmosphere that supports and encourages students to complete their homework, to the best of their ability. The facility provides all students with the opportunity to aspire to reach their full potential.

In addition to this, if a student is experiencing difficulties with completing homework to an acceptable standard by the agreed timeframe, parents will be contacted by the school – Mr Lister or Mr Scott and offered support from the school. The usual indicator for this is the accumulation of three or more behaviour points by a student in the half-term. The aim is for students to become more independent and improve the standard of their homework, which will avoid any unnecessary behaviour points or detentions.
